28 reconsideration request. Pursuant to the provisions of California Insurance Code section

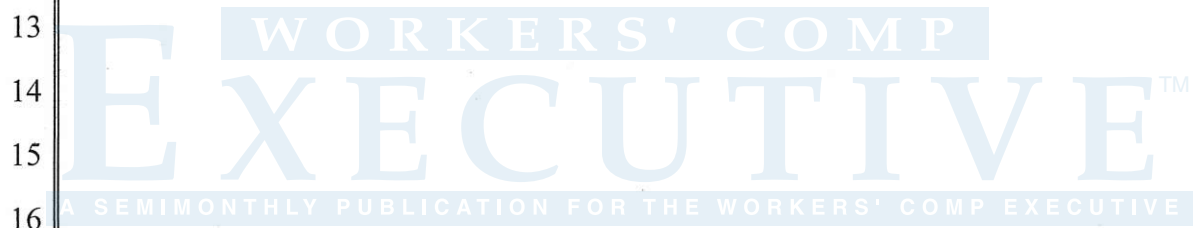
1 11737(f), as well as California Code of Regulations, Title 10, sections 2509.72 and 2509.74, IT IS
